Access to Home

Helping you stay in your home

Assists homeowners or tenants, with landlord approval, with accessibility modifications to either prevent institutionalization or to allow people living with disabilities to return home from an institution. This program is implemented in partnership with ARISE, Enable, Loretto, PEACE, Inc. and the Onondaga County Department of Aging and Youth. Applications for this program are available at partner agencies only. Deferred loans of up to \$25,000 are available. This is a limited grant funded through the New York State Department of Housing and Community Renewal.

Eligibility: Onondaga County (program's funding priority is the city of Syracuse)

Program Information

- Up to \$25,000 for accessibility modifications (ramps, widening doorways, bathroom and kitchen rehab, etc)
- For homeowners AND renters (with Landlord approval)
- Participants must be 80% of median or below
- Participants must be frail elderly or disabled (modifications help person remain in home)
- This is considered a deferred loan (no payback provided they live in the home for the term of the loan)
- If the person dies or moves to an assisted living facility, loan is forgiven
- Property taxes and water bills must be current
- Must have homeowners insurance
